#### CONSTRUCTION

- Materials used: infusion of polyester resin and high quality anti-osmosis resin on a balsa sandwich frame and fibre glass skin. Hull bottom and keel in infused solid laminate.
- Structural bulkheads (infused balsa sandwich)
- Bilge painted light grey.
- Hull finished with white gel coat.
- Deck in white gel coat with diamond type nonslip

#### STEERING EQUIPMENT

- 2 hung, foam sandwich fibreglass rudder blades with stainless steel rudder stock
- Epoxy rudder stock tubes.
- Self-aligning upper and lower bearings.
- Fully hydraulicsteering mechanism:
- 1 hydraulic jack per rudder blade
- hydraulic system in starboard engine compartment.

#### **PROPULSION - ENGINE AND GEARS**

- Access to engine compartment from transoms via hatches with stainless steel jacks.
- 2 YANMAR Sail drive 54hp Diesel engines
